Abstract.

We intend to discuss the difficulties encountered in preparing the Project Guidelines (D.I.P.) regarding the restoration of three churches badly damaged in the 2016 earthquakes in the territories of Amatrice and Accumoli, including the numerous problems encountered during the handing over of the guidelines for the implementation phase.

The guidelines were drawn up by the undersigned as architect of the Ministry of Cultural Heritage and presented, by the Ministry, to the Diocese of Rieti. As a private organization, the Diocese can now directly employ professionals of their choice for the implementation phase of the project, without the need to carry out a public competition for the planning and management of the works. This will shorten the time for reopening the churches, but risks perverting the 'soft' design projections that were planned in the initial document.
